4.1.Methodological overview

The Master's Final Project (MFP) is an original piece of work that promotes student autonomous work. Therefore, there are no lectures nor practice sessions in this course, but tutorials with the project supervisors.

The supervision of the Master Final Project has been traditionally organised in Workshops, led by a teacher specialised in architectural projects, or by Coordinated groups of teachers from different knowledge areas, from which supervisors are assigned to each student. In both cases, the topics of the MFP are normally linked to the contents of the compulsory courses of the first semester. However, students can also propose free MFP topics under the supervision of teachers of the Master.

4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- Autonomous work by the student.
- Tutorials with the supervisors of the MFP.
- Additionally, some activities may be offered by the Workshops or the Coordinated groups of teachers to reinforce the good development of the students' work, such as formative evaluation (through the revision of the project conceptual and scheme design) that allows to guide students in a timely and pertinent way about the strengths and areas for improvement of their projects.
