1. General information

The Degree Final Project will demonstrate the knowledge, skills, aptitudes and attitudes acquired by the student throughout the degree. It will constitute an autonomous and personal work of the student. Papers will contain sufficient elements of personal creation and will adequately cite all sources used.

The Final Degree Project can contribute to the achievement of the goals of all the SDGs given its cross-cutting nature and territorial. In this subject the knowledge acquired during the studies is applied to the design and realization of an original geographic work, in the field of fundamental research or professional practice, in which the student will demonstrate that he/she has achieved the competences of the degree.

2. Learning results

In order to pass this subject, the students shall demonstrate they have acquired the following results:

- Apply the conceptual, theoretical and methodological geographic foundations of the discipline to a research or professional project.
- Demonstrate competence in the search, critical analysis and synthesis of geographic information.
- Demonstrate mastery of scientific terminology and use of acquired techniques and tools
- Elaborate technical reports and complex documents that gather the different methodological phases and results of the work - Synthesize and publicly present a research work or professional profile, using the appropriate communication techniques.
- Demonstrate intellectual integrity and ethical commitment
- Demonstrate that you are able to undertake postgraduate studies

3. Syllabus

4. Academic activities

Students will carry out their work on a subject of their choice and under the supervision of at least one director. Whatever the modality chosen (specific academic work, specific work carried out in the laboratory, work resulting from an internship or a stay at another university), they will require the preparation of a written report with a minimum length of 1,000 words per credit.

Joint activities for all students: briefing and seminar to present the progress of the work work progress.

Individual activities: periodic orientation and follow-up sessions with the director.

5. Assessment system

Assessment tests: The Degree Final Project will be materialized in a descriptive report that will be evaluated according to the current regulations for Final Degree Projects of the University of Zaragoza.

Assessment criteria:

1. Descriptive report: Quality of the content and structure of the work, the ability to propose hypotheses and to use the appropriate methodologies, critical spirit, creative and innovative capacity, written communication skills and the quality of the formal aspects.
2. Oral presentation (if applicable): Explanation of the methods used, their appropriateness to the proposal, the oral communication skills and the conclusions obtained.

The procedures for reviewing and claiming the grades obtained will be those established in the evaluation regulations in force at the University of Zaragoza.
