1. General information

The objective of the internships is to provide students with work experience as a complement to their academic training . Bringing them closer to the business world, facilitating job placement and promoting entrepreneurial ideas are also part of our objectives.

The possibility of completing their studies with internships in companies is also a first foray into the world of work for which they are preparing.

The activities to be developed are determined by the specific company or by the student's requirements on a specific topic and their occupation will be aimed at an approach and knowledge of the professional and business activity.

All Collaboration Agreements are regulated by Royal Decree 592/2014 of July 11, 2014, which regulates external academic internships for university students.

This subject aims to bring together the efforts of all actors in a society to assume equal responsibility for the fulfillment of the 2030 Agenda the 2030 Agenda, so each practice will be associated with an SDG that will be further developed (for this purpose, an orientation and evaluation guide will be provided)

2. Learning results

- Convey information, ideas, problems and solutions to both specialized and non-specialized audiences. Encourage entrepreneurship.

3. Syllabus

Given the nature of the course, each practice is developed in a specific time and environment, so the program and content of the practices will be made specifically for each student concerned. As criteria for the content, will take into account the goals of the Grade and the Learning results and SDGs that are expected to be worked on.

4. Academic activities

Students, within the established deadlines, will submit an application form (Form B) for internships at companies. Those students who have passed 50% of the credits will have priority for internships, although it will be mandatory to have passed at least 90 credits of the degree.

Before the start of the internship, the collaborating entity or the student him/herself (as indicated by the entity) must notify the Department of the start date of the internship and send the complete information on the internship according to Model C. The EUPLA Internship Department will complete the agreement and send it, for signature, to all the parties involved.

For the development of the internship and its subsequent assessment, it will be estimated an equivalence of 40 hours of internships in companies per ECTS.

The application period for summer internships is April. The rest of the year, remains open to apply for internships at other times.

5. Assessment system

The student will write a report on the activity carried out, in which the following aspects will be explicitly reflected:

- Initial objectives of the practice and degree of compliance.
- Summary of the work performed.
- Results and conclusions.

The student must submit a copy of the report together with a certificate from the company to the Secretary's Office of the Center. This report will be reviewed by the person in charge of the Internship Department, evaluating the internship period carried out by the student, together with the evidence provided by the company.
