The master's final project (MFP) is an individual research project that will be carried out after completing the entire program of subjects of the master's degree. It will focus on a specific topic related to the field of study of the master's degree.

Its main objective will be to address a relevant problem, to investigate it in depth, to analyse data and to present well-founded conclusions.

In addition, an oral defence before a board of examiners will be mandatory to evaluate the quality and relevance of the work done.

These approaches and objectives are aligned with the following Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations Agenda 2030 (<https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/es/>), in such a way that the acquisition of the learning results of the subject provides training and knowledge, skills and competencies to contribute to some extent to their achievement."
