4. Methodology, learning tasks, syllabus and resources

4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as project-based learning tasks, presentations, seminars, research and bibliographic search, readings, tutorials, lectures, workshops, and assignments.

4.2. Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- Lectures.
- Workshops.
- Seminars. Follow-up of the exhibitions with specific interventions of dialectical nature to clarify, explain, synthesize, etc. Proposal of group techniques for the development of creative capacity. Presentation of illustrative creative experiences for the Fine Arts curriculum from the point of psychology.
- Bibliographic search. Facilitation of bibliographic and documentary sources and resources for the theoretical synthesis of the contents. Individual assignments.
- Readings. Support materials for the searching process and documentary preparation of students, especially related

to the projects and assignments.

- Projects and supervised assignments. Supervision of practical assignments' progress, coordination of its application and estimation of its possibilities of artistic experimentation, taking into account the analysis and application of the main psychological processes.
- Presentation of projects for class discussion and critical thinking.

4.3. Syllabus

The course will address the following topics.

- Topic 0. Introduction to Multimedia Learning
- Topic 1. Sensation, perception, attention and memory
- Topic 2. Emotion and human motivation
- Topic 3. Psychology of learning, association, conditioning
- Topic 4. Optimum experience, creativity
- Topic 5. Psychopathology and artistic creation
- Topic 6. Critical view and scientific basis for different art-based therapies
