4. Methodology, learning tasks, syllabus and resources

4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology developed in the subject combines various learning situations, which address the following learning processes:

- Listening, reading and presentation of concepts, documentation and reference articles on theoretical topics, as the basis for the practical part of the subject.
- Activities for the application of concepts, debates and discussions around various teaching-learning situations, corresponding to different levels of learning the Aragonese language in Early Childhood Education and Primary Education.
- Design and planning of various activities and teaching resources appropriate to the teaching of Aragonese literature in different situations and levels.
- Analysis and collective comment of the developed designs.

4.2. Learning tasks

Face-to-face activities (60 hours):

- 1. Presentation of contents by teachers.
- 2. Final evaluation test.
- 3. Practices of the subject.

Regarding the practical face-to-face activities, they will consist of the presentation and comment of tasks in class. The teaching staff will determine the possibility of forming work groups and/or requesting individual work to carry out the following activities:

• Realization in class of activities of reflection, comment, debate and application, from theoretical contents, legislation, technical procedures, scientific or academic texts, didactic resources, digital supports, etc.

The possibility of making external trips will be considered, as well as the organization of conferences or seminars with guest speakers that facilitate the acquisition of the skills of the subject.

Non-face-to-face activities (90 hours):

- 1. Autonomous work: readings and personal study of scientific texts and legislation in the area for comment and discussion in class.
- 2. Carrying out directed academic activities, applying the guidelines offered by the teaching staff.
- 3. Study and exam preparation.
- 4. Volunteer activities. Students who so wish, on their own initiative or at the suggestion of the teaching staff, may carry out voluntary activities or tasks related to the field of knowledge of the subject.

The tutorial follow-up and the direction of works can be carried out electronically.

4.3. Syllabus

- 1. Introduction to literature in Aragonese. From the Middle Ages to contemporary times: main stages, works and authors. Poetry, narrative, theater and essay from the 19th and 20th centuries. Methodology and basic concepts in literary studies applied to the study of literature in Aragonese.
- Principles of children's literary discourse and theoretical foundations of literary education in Early Childhood Education and Primary Education. Methodology and resources for teaching children's and youth literature. Promotion of reading habits in Early Childhood Education and Primary Education.
- 3. Children's and youth literature in Aragonese. The classical genres: poetry, narrative and theater.
- 4. The new genres of the LIJ and its value in the acquisition of the Aragonese language.

The calendar of face-to-face sessions and the presentation of papers will be communicated through the Digital Teaching Ring (ADD) or in a written document delivered by the teaching staff.
