1. General information

The main objective of this subject is to acquire the necessary skills to work in a center of Secondary Education from interaction and coexistence in the classroom and the teaching-learning processes, as well as to know how to plan a curricular and instructive design for the development of innovative learning activities in Geography and History and to develop in parallel an educational research in the classroom.

These approaches and objectives are aligned with the following Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations Agenda 2030 (<https://www.un.org/sustainabledevelopment/es/>), in such a way that the acquisition of the learning results of the subject provides training and competence to contribute to some extent to their achievement.

Methodologies and learning activities:

- Participative attendance during the hours assigned to Practicum II.
- Observation by the master's students of the dynamics of the secondary school.
- In-depth analysis of the documents to be reviewed in order to achieve the results and competencies set.
- Contact of the master's students with teachers and other educational agents to be informed about the functioning and materials to be able to achieve the results and competencies set, as well as the evaluation
- Attendance to Practicum II tutor meetings.

5. Assessment system

In order to be evaluated, it is mandatory to carry out the following classroom activities:

1. Stay in the destination center complying with the minimum period established by the internship regulations established by the DGA.
2. Attendance to all tutorials scheduled by faculty or center tutors.
3. Completion of all scheduled activities as detailed below.

Activities programmed to be carried out in the classroom during Practicum II:

1. Classroom teaching of a didactic unit, following the indications of the tutor in charge, and applying the designs made in the subject of Design of activities, as far as possible.
2. Field work of the project of the Innovation and Research subject.

An **internship report** will be submitted, which should reflect the following

- (a) the implementation of a didactic unit in the practice center, following the indications of the tutor in charge, and in application of the criteria and designs made in the subject "Activity Design", as far as possible and
- (b) the field work of the Innovation and research project: specific experiences and collection of evidence

The evaluation of the subject will be carried out according to the following criteria:

Directed work (internship report): 70 %

Attendance and participation in the internship center (internship tutor's report): 30 %

In any case, as part of the evaluation, the teacher may request, randomly or whenever they deems it appropriate, the oral defence of the written test or assignment, for the verification of the grade.

Finally, it must be taken into account that the Regulations of the Rules of Coexistence of the University of Zaragoza will be applicable to irregularities committed in the evaluation tests through academic fraud, as well as the application of article 30 of the Regulations of the Rules of Evaluation of Learning in relation to irregular practices other than academic fraud.
