



EPISTEMIC PLAY BEHAVIOUR	LUDIC PLAY BEHAVIOUR
Is concerned with acquisition of knowledge and problem solving	Is playful, is fun
Gathers information	Is lacking on specific focus
Is exploratory	Is highly mood dependent
Is productive	Has constraints which are imposed by the child
Discovers	Does not need to involve adults
Is invention, task or work orientated	Requires that adults should be sensitive to children's needs
Is relatively independently of mood state	Can be changed by intensive intervention
Needs adults to:	Has the key features of enjoyment and fantasy
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Support- Encourage- Answer questions- Supply information- Be involved	Is unconstrained
	Is symbolic
	Is repetitive
	Is innovative.


