

ANEXO I: QUALITY SCORING SYSTEMS (Murison, 2001)

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| Sedation | 0 | No sedation | |
| | 1 | Mild | Quieter, but still bright and active |
| | 2 | Moderate | Quiet, reluctant to move, ataxic, able to walk |
| | 3 | Profound | Unable to walk unaided |
| Tracheal intubation | 0 | Smooth | No swallowing, coughing, tongue/jaw movement |
| | 1 | Fair | Some tongue movement, slight cough |
| | 2 | Poor | Marked tongue/jaw movement, swallowing |
| | 3 | Very poor | As 2 but requiring additional induction agent |
| Quality of anaesthetic induction | 0 | Smooth | Without excitement |
| | 1 | Fair | Slight excitement/muscle twitching/limb movement |
| | 2 | Poor | Marked excitement/muscle twitching/limb movement |
| | 3 | Very poor | As 2 plus vocalization |
