All the students are required to write a dissertation, based on an individual choice of topic.

There are four kinds of dissertation: Academic research, laboratory research, job experience or stay in other center. The learning and teaching methodology developed is designed to help the students to choose and refine their research aims, to select appropriate methods and techniques for the research, and to write up the analysis and interpretation of the findings in a logical and well-structured document supported by references to the relevant academic literature. The students work under the guidance and supervision of at

least one director. By the end of the research period a written document of at least 12,000 words must be prepared according the following structure:

- Introduction
- Background and state of the art
- Objectives and Methodology
- Analytical Development
- Conclusions
- List of sources, bibliography and resources used
