5.3.Program

Syllabus (or programme)

- I. Linguistic theories and grammar of Spanish as a foreign language. Formal/functional paradigm. Grammar and communicative competence. Educational grammar: from a focus on forms to a focus on the form.
- II. Levels of linguistic competence. Selection of grammatical contents by levels. Analysis of grammatical needs. Management of the grammatical acquisition process and of the objectives and results of the grammar programme.
- III. Grammar. Selection and presentation of the most important problems related to morphology and syntax in the teaching/learning of Spanish as a foreign language: Ser/estar, the indicative/subjunctive, past tenses, etc.
- IV. Lexicon. Selection criteria. Organisation and presentation. The dictionary in Spanish as a Foreign Language classes.
- V. Phonetics. Pronunciation. Intonation. Accent and rhythm. Graphic representation and orthography.
- VI. Which Spanish to teach. Spanish and its varieties. The language model.
- VII. Online grammar resources for Spanish as a Foreign Language classes.
