5.1. General methodological presentation

The learning process that is designed for this subject is based on the following:

The learning process that is designed for this subject is based on a theoretical and practical part. The theoretical part of the course will be presented by the teacher in the appropriate classes. The practical classes have the dual aim of extending some developed content in the theoretical part, on the one hand, and to encourage student participation on the other. To achieve both purposes exercises that complement relevant aspects of the subject and debates on specific readings are combined.

5.2. Learning activities

The program includes the following learning activities ...

- 1 Lectures: 60 hours
- 2 Practical Classes and workshops: 60 hours
- 3 Personal study: 175 hours
- 4 Evaluation: 5 hours

The teaching activities Type 1 consist basically of lectures with the group as a whole.

The teacher will present the most important concepts of each topic. Students should read in advance the specific material, extracting the basic concepts. They must also complete the information on the issues that are exposed in the classroom, using required and recommended readings.

The teaching activities Type 2 will involve a practical approach to the subject, through exchanges of ideas, discussions, problems, cases, individual and / or group exercises. These activities will take place on the dates indicated and established in the schedule.

Teaching activities Type 6, in the part of Sociology (7.5 hours) will consist of the preparation of two reports on the topics proposed for practices Type 2, by using databases indicated in class. In Unit IV. Economics, Type 6 activities (7.5 hours) consist in practical exercises on topics related to population aging and its impact on health and pension matters.
