5.1. General methodological presentation

- Project elaboration: (i) participatory classes, using audiovisual media to show the fundamentals of R+D+i project elaboration, management and evaluation, and web pages to widen the information; (ii) seminars, where the students, working in groups, will critically analyze examples of R+D+i projects and will carry out simulations on R+D+i project evaluations, following the established criteria; (iii) finally, once the program of face-to-face classes is finished, the students will elaborate a paper dissertation about the proposal of a specific R+D+i project in agreement with the criteria of a specific call of the Food Science and Technology Area (European, National or Regional). The learning process of the part of the course dedicated to the tools of oral communication and exposure are based on an active methodology learning by doing supported by tools with continuous evaluation of all activities undertaken by the student, both addressed as developed in the actual classes with the final individual project of the subject.
