The learning process that has been designed for this subject comprises two activities: the writing of a paper under the supervision of a director and its later defense before a panel.

Under the guidance of her director, the student will go through the necessary sources to obtain relevant information in order to analyze the issues related to the paper.

The memorandum therefore must reflect the work developed autonomously and personally by the student.

However, TFG may take one of the following forms:



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- A) A written paper. It may even be referred to a stay in another University. In any casse, the public defense of the paper must be carried out in all cases at the University of Zaragoza Law School.
- B) A memorandum referred to the results of practices engaged into by the student at companies or institutions. This memorandum may take two forms:
- Opinion on a legal issue dealt with during the practices. For example, an opinion on a trial in which the Student has assumed a leading role whether contributing with jurisprudence and doctrinal studies for the legal foundation of the positions of her client.
- Professional project developed by the student during her practices that involve the development of competencies associated to the Degree in Law. For example, the design of an IPO of a company in which the student has participated in a direct way, or on how to approach legal urban planning.
