4.1. Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as: lectures in big group, practice sessions in small groups or Service-Learning experiences and an individual or group project.

4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- 1. LECTURES IN THE BIG GROUP: Explanation and orientation for the personal study of the different contents of the subject, aiming at the acquisition of competences and learning results.
- 2. PRACTICE SESSIONS IN GROUPS. Methodology: simulation, role playing, service-learning, practical cases, teamwork, collaborative work.

- Topic IV: Important aspects for intervention in social participation and community.
