#### **4.1.Methodological overview**

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards the achievement of the learning objectives. It is based on the following strategies:

1. To make the student aware of the learning process, and demonstrate they are able to continue learning on their own after the class has ended.
2. To train in social and ethical values.
3. To train in quality, promoting active and participative methods.

A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as theory and practice sessions and case studies.

### 4.2.Learning tasks

This course is organized as follows:

- **Theory sessions** (90 hours). Teachers explain the fundamental principles of the subject matter.
- **Practice sessions** (30 hours). Work with electronic resources, reading of judgments and papers.
- **Case studies**
- **Autonomous work and study** (160 hours). Reading and preparation of texts, implementing theoretical knowledge to practice sessions.
- **Tutorials** (12 hours).
