2.2.Learning goals

The subject and its expected results respond to the following general objectives and objectives:

We must not forget that the students have an experiential knowledge of the Centers, since they have been immersed in the educational system in the different stages, so this experience will provide references from another perspective.

The observation, the search for information and the contrast of ideas and opinions, are strategies that the student must put into practice during this first stay, so that they provide new knowledge of the real functioning of the centers.

All this implies the elaboration of strategies of coordination between the contents of the subjects of the first semester (modules 1, 2 and 3) with the practicum I and the centers of non-university education.

In the field of professional training, this practicum must involve an approach to the business typology corresponding to the different productive sectors. In the specialty of guidance involves approaching the subject of psychopedagogical assessment, attention to diversity and advice to teachers, students and families.

The main objective of this course is that students begin in the acquisition of those skills necessary to perform in a Secondary Education center, Vocational Training, other special education, or Adult Education or in in a special education



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center, and that they know how the organizational aspects and coordinated work in the center work and the coordination with the environment and its resources. These aspects must be later reflected in the Final Master's Project that each student will perform, as a compendium of the training acquired throughout the teachings described.
