This course will address the following topics:

1. Experimental cinema: Introduction and Manifestos.

- 2. Critique of modernity and creation of a new language.
- 3. Symbolic image and attacks to reason. Two generations of Surrealist cinema.
- 4. The naked eye. Phenomenology and cinema.
- 5. Everyday life, documentary and autobiography.
- 6. Politics and critique of the cinematographic image. Truths and lies of documentary image.
- 7. Cinema as a register of the real (and of the imagined). Post-documentary and essay-film.
- 8. Reconstructed images. Cinematographic dispositives and Structural cinema.
- 9. Still images and expanded temporalities.
- 10. Anticinematographic cinema. Body, interruption and accidents. Performative images.
- 11. Vision and knowledge. Mystic cinema.
