4.1.Methodological overview

The learning process in this course is based, on one hand, upon the lecturers' theoretical explanation during the classes. In these they will expose the most important aspect of literary education and the main traits of children's literature from both a diachronic and actual perspective, in order to provide the students with a basic training on reading formation. On the other hand, individual and group tasks will be assigned to the students. These tasks will imply always a practical and reflexive application of the theoretical concepts explained by the lecturers.

Classroom tasks (60 hours for the students)
