4.1.Methodological overview

The methodology followed in this course is oriented towards achievement of the learning objectives. A wide range of teaching and learning tasks are implemented, such as lectures, practical exercises, individual and group tasks, guided tasks, field work, autonomous work and study.

Practical exercises will be developed both in the classroom (practical exercises and seminars) and outside (supervised exercises and field work). Therein, students must look for information, select it, rating it, systematize it and prepare it for a public presentation.

Students are expected to participate actively in the class throughout the semester.

Classroom materials will be available via Moodle. These include a repository of the lecture notes used in class, the course syllabus, as well as other course-specific learning materials.

4.2.Learning tasks

The course includes the following learning tasks:

- Lectures (30 hours)
- Individual and/or group tasks (15 hours).
- Field work (8 hours)
- Guided tasks (17 hours)
- Autonomous work and study (75 hours)

4.3.Syllabus

The course will address the following topics:

1. Introduction: introductory remarks of the Geography of Aragón.
2. The physical environment and natural landscapes: characterization of the components of the natural environment (relief, climate, vegetation, soils...). Explanatory factors of their spatial distribution. The natural landscapes of the Region.
3. The population and settlement. Characterization of the Aragón's population (temporal evolution, distribution, structure, etc.).
4. Economic activities: characterization of the productive sectors (agriculture, livestock, forestry, industry, tertiary activities). Explanatory factors of their spatial distribution.
5. Spatial planning and problematic environmental in Aragón.
